Despite the significant impact of the pandemic on the education of most HKDSE candidates in recent years, our students have demonstrated remarkable resilience and unwavering focus during the examinations. Through their perseverance, consistent effort & unwavering support from their parents and teachers, we have achieved an unprecedented milestone this year. They have attained historic heights in obtaining grades of 5/5*/5**, as well as meeting the university entrance requirements at an impressive percentage. Nineteen students obtained scholarships from Po Leung Kuk. Students with best performances are CHAN Tsz Ching陳芷晴 (five 5**, two5*), WU Chun Chi 胡臻緻 (four 5**, three 5*), TOU Cheuk Lun杜倬綸 (four 5**, two5*, two 5), CHEUNG Lok Hang張洛珩 (four 5**, two5*, one 4), CHEUNG Wai Hong張煒康 (four 5**, one 5*, two 5, one 4).

Moreover, nearly 90% of our students succeeded in being admitted to various degree programmes offered by HKU, CUHK, HKUST, PolyU, CityU & EDUHK. They include the disciplines of studies in Medicine, Dental, Pharmacy, Nursing, Speech therapy, Occupational Therapy, Global Business, Finance, Engineering, Occupational Therapy, Business Administration, Languages, Education, Accounting, Technology & Artificial Intelligence, Journalism & Communication, Fashion, Biotechnology, Psychology, Pure Science, Urban Studies, Philosophy, and many others.
